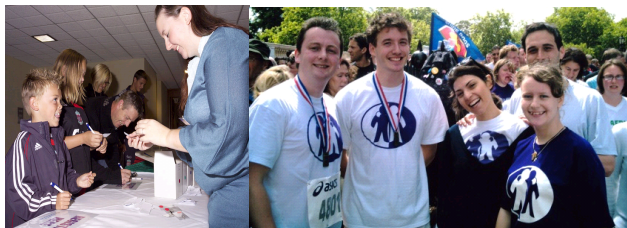




## Get Involved
